

Dark Shadows

Portraits can often be improved by lightening dark shadows under the eyes.

- 1. Select an image that would improve with dark eye shadows being lightened.
- 2. Use the Clone tool and select a brush that is a little smaller than the areas you want to cover in one pass.
- 3. Set the Clone Tool Mode to Lighten so only darker pixels than the sample will be affected.
- 4. Set the opacity to 50% for more control. This may mean several passes are necessary to lighten the area.
- 5. Select an area below the dark shadows and Option/Alt-Click to sample an area.
- 6. Clone over the dark shadows, resampling and making multiple passes as necessary.
