

Wrinkle Removal

De-aging: Wrinkle Removal

- 1. Open an image to de-age.
- 2. Create a new layer from the background image, Cmd/Cntrl-J
- 3. Use the Healing Tool to remove wrinkles. Initially make a select (Option or Alt key) on a smooth area such as the cheeks.
- 4. With all the wrinkles removed the image looks fake. Adjust the layer opacity to bring back some of the underlying wrinkles. Around 50% usually works well.
- 5. To whiten teeth, use the Select> Color Range. This will select too much so use the Marquee and Lasso to deselect (with the Option/Alt key) unwanted areas.
- 6. Switch to Quick Mask Tool (Q). Double-click the Quick Mask tool to change the default red to green for easier visibility. Clean up any areas around the
- 7. Create a new layer with the selected teeth, Cmd/ Cntrl-J.
- 8. Set the layer mode to Screen. Adjust opacity to a more realistic setting such as 25-30%.
